Credit & Debit Card Travel Tips

Before you take off on that trip you've been planning, take a moment to understand some of the things you should do to ensure safe, problem-free spending.

Prior to Departure

Plan ahead! Make sure you have several methods (Cornerstone debit card, Cornerstone credit card, etc.) of getting cash and making purchases, in case one method is lost or stolen. Keep these items in separate places while traveling. Verify which payment types your destination accepts.

Contact the Credit Union that issues each of your credit or debit cards and let them know when and where you will be traveling. If you don't, your cards may be suspended for suspicion of fraud as several common vacation destinations are high-risk areas.

Keep contact information and phone numbers for Cornerstone Credit Union on hand. Keep the information in a separate location in case your wallet or purse is lost or stolen.

Check the daily cash withdrawal limit, daily purchase limit, or credit limit for each of your cards.

Check the expiration date on each credit or debit card. If the card will expire while you're away, contact your credit union and request a new card be sent to you as soon as possible

Sign up for CCU [Online](#) so you can view daily account activity while traveling. Remember to only use reliable and safe means to access the internet, use antivirus on any device you are using, and download our convenient [Mobile App](#).

Memorize and test the PIN number of each of your cards.

Make copies of all of your cards and keep in a separate, secure place.

While Traveling

When using your card while traveling, keep the payment slips, ATM receipts etc. You are liable for the amount written on it so make sure it is correct. Plus, you can review it later.

Only utilize well-lit and safe ATMs and merchants. Look at the logos on the back of your card for easy access to your card networks. In the U.S., look for surcharge-free [MoneyPass or Alliance One](#) ATM Network.
